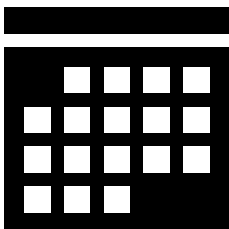
Gateway's Inaugural Pickleball Tournament Fundraiser Sponsorships and Vendor/Partner Booth Opportunities
