As Gateway's Lead Housing Navigator, Naom's duties will include connecting clients with housing opportunities through community partners; assisting with housing search; landlord liaison role; coordination of care in relation to clients' various housing needs; and completing the VI-SPDAT assessment tool. Naom is excited to build the Housing Navigation program at Gateway through connections with community partners and landlords to provide clients with more opportunities for safe, affordable housing.

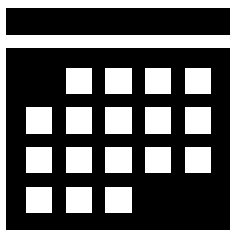
