A Safety Plan Could Make All the Difference in Times of Crisis





A safety plan is a personalized, practical plan to improve your safety, the safety of your children and your pets when experiencing abuse, preparing to leave an abusive situation, or after you leave.

In times of crisis, it's important to have a plan to ensure that you are able to escape at a moment's notice. This could mean determining and rehearsing escape routes, having emergency bags packed, leaving copies of documents and supplies with a trusted friend or neighbor, and discussing quick-escape plans with your children ahead of time.

Three Birds Alliance has a comprehensive **Safety Planning Guide available online** that we encourage everyone to review and share with those who might be in crisis, and our 24/7 crisis hotline is available every day of the year at any time of day or night at 303.343.1851.
