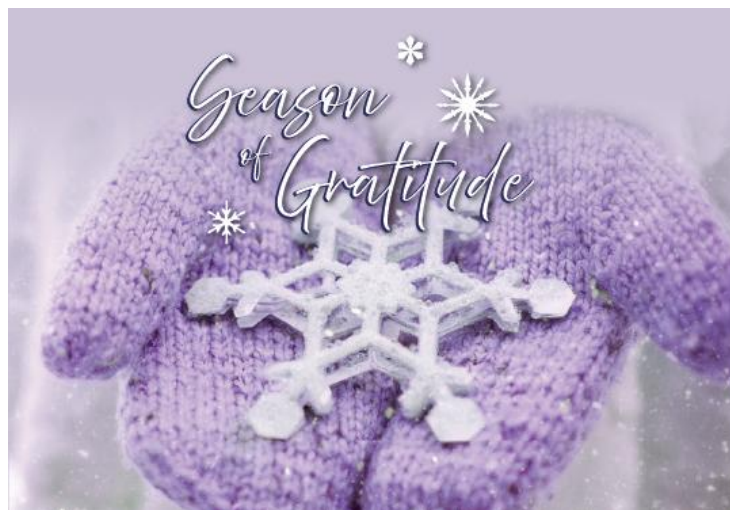

These are difficult times for many organizations, but especially for Three Birds Alliance. Due to Federal and State funding cuts, Three Birds Alliance is facing a **\$150,000 funding cut for 2026**, which will impact the organization and the people it serves in drastic ways including the forced closure of our in-house counseling program and a reduction in the number of Child/Family advocates we can employ.

We hope you will consider an end-of-year gift to Three Birds Alliance and will help spread the word to people you know to also donate.

Reasons to support Three Birds Alliance:

- More than 800,000 Coloradans are impacted by domestic violence, many of whom are children who witness the abuse of a parent.
- On average, 37% of women and 31% of men in Colorado have experienced intimate partner violence. That's more than 800,000 Coloradans.
- 57% of women & children who experience homelessness cite domestic violence as the immediate cause for their homelessness.
- 1,800 victims were served in 2024 with Court advocacy, Child/Family advocacy, legal aid, food assistance, and housing navigation.
- A combined 8,000 nights of shelter were provided in 2024.
- Nearly 4,000 calls were answered on the 24/7 crisis line.

A donation to Three Birds Alliance provides more than just shelter. It's a gift of safety, connection, and hope for a future free of violence.
